

Ship Simulator Extremes Donation Edition Contest Rules:

1. VSTEP/Greenpeace reserves the right to change the dates and or terms of this contest without notice. Changes will be posted at the Ship Simulator Site at <http://www.shipsim.com/>
2. This contest is open to all owners of the donation edition of Ship Simulator Extremes that have opted in for this contest during donation edition purchase, with the exception of Greenpeace employees and their immediate families and VSTEP employees and their immediate families.
3. First prize is a bunk onboard the new Rainbow Warrior for the winner and a friend. The trip will consist of an overnight stay onboard, departing from the port closest to the winner's residence. Greenpeace agrees to transport the winner and a friend to the departure port and return them home and will cover all costs associated with their stay onboard the Rainbow Warrior. The dates for travel are to be advised but will be personally communicated with the winner to ensure all arrangements are suitable. The new Rainbow Warrior will be launched from a port in Germany in October 2011 and Greenpeace will ensure that the trip takes place within six months of launch of the new boat.
4. The winner will be asked to participate in the crewing of the ship as a volunteer deckhand, and perform light duties indicated by the Bosun. (We'll go easy on you!) If willing, we may ask the winner to make statements which Greenpeace can use for media and publicity purposes.
5. The prize is offered as is and is not transferable or exchangeable for cash, alternate trip dates, or goods and services except at the discretion of Greenpeace. While every effort will be made to accommodate the winner's schedule in arranging arrival and departure dates, Greenpeace reserves the right to award the prize to the second place winner, third place winner, and so on until a winner able to travel on the arranged dates is found.
6. Rules: Greenpeace, together with VSTEP will make the random draw for the winner on the 1st October 2011.
7. Conditions/Restrictions. Any winner selected for travel will be required to ensure their own travel documentation is up to date. Each winner will be required to sign an affidavit of eligibility and release, including a publicity release, as prepared by Greenpeace prior to receiving their prize. The Contest is void where prohibited by law. Anyone using fraudulent means to participate and/or win the Contest will be disqualified.
8. Release and Indemnification. In exchange for the right to participate in the Contest, each participant agrees to release and indemnify VSTEP & Greenpeace, and its officers, directors, agents, licensees, subsidiaries and employees (the "Released Parties"), from any and all claims, demands and/or causes of action of any nature or kind whatsoever, whether presently known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen, that arise out of the participant's participation in the contest.
